

Evaluation criteria

EXAM FROM THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE FOR CANDIDATES FOR STUDIES AT THE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY OF SILESIA IN KATOWICE

(In accordance with the Order No. 144/2025 dated 11.07.2025. of the Rector of the Medical University of Silesia in Katowice)

When evaluating questions 1 and 3, the following criteria are taken into account:

1. **Content** – the clarity of the presented content and development of the topic are evaluated (scoring: 0-2)
2. **Language means** – the richness of language means, vocabulary and diversity of lexical and grammatical structures are evaluated (scoring: 0-2)
3. **Linguistic correctness** – the correctness of linguistic means is taken into account; grammatical, lexical errors and their impact on the communicativeness of the speech (scoring: 0-2)
4. **Fluency of speech** – the ability to express thoughts freely without excessive repetitions or interruptions is evaluated (scoring: 0-2)

When evaluating question 2, the following criteria are taken into account:

1. **Phonetic correctness** – the correct pronunciation is evaluated (scoring: 0-2)
2. **Reading comprehension** – the ability to answer the question to the text factually and grammatically correctly is evaluated (scoring: 0-2)

Maximum number of points from the exam: **20 points**
